Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy applies to Dream Teens Community Foundation “DTCF” including but not limited to www.dreamteenscf.org. This Privacy Policy describes the collection, use, and disclosure of users’ information on our website. This Privacy Policy describes how we collect, use, and safeguard the information you provide to us. By using the website, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Types of Data Collected

While using our website, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

- First Name and Last Name
- Email Address
- Phone Number
- Address, State, Province, ZIP/Postal code, City
- Payment Data
- Usage Data

Payment Data

Payment Data includes personal account or financial information collected from a credit card, debit card, PayPal, and Zelle, including but not limited to a cardholder’s account number, card expiration date, and CVV2.

Usage Data

Usage Data is collected automatically when using our website. Usage Data may include information such as your device’s Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our website that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

When you access the website by or through a mobile device, we may collect certain information automatically, including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device you use, your mobile device unique ID, the IP address of your mobile device, your mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser you use, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our website or when you access the website by or through a mobile device.

Use of Tracking Technologies and Cookies

DTCF website may use “Cookies” and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on our website and store certain information. Technologies used are beacons, tags, and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze our service. The technologies we use may include:

- **Cookies or Browser Cookies.** A cookie is a small text file that is placed on your Device by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. However, if you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of DTCF’s website. Unless you have adjusted Your browser setting so that it will refuse Cookies, our Service may use Cookies.
- **Web Beacons.** Certain sections of our service and our emails may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit DTCF, for example, to count users who have visited those pages or opened an email and for other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of a certain section and verifying system and server integrity).

Use of Your Personal Information

DTCF collects and uses your personal information to operate and deliver the services you have requested.

Such as:

- **Charity donations, registrations for DTCF events, volunteering, and partnership / sponsorship opportunities.**
- **To contact you:** by email, telephone calls, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication, such as a mobile application's push notifications regarding updates
- **To provide you with news,** special offers and general information about our program services and events which we offer that are similar to those that you have already registered or enquired about unless you have opted not to receive such information.
- **To manage your requests:** To attend and manage your requests to us.
- **For other purposes:** We may use your information for other purposes, such as data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns and to evaluate and improve our services, marketing, and your experience.

DTCF may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from DTCF and its affiliates.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

DTCF does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. DTCF may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties

are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to DTCF, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Retention of Your Personal Data

DTCF will retain your personal data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your personal data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

DTCF will also retain usage data for internal analysis purposes. Usage data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of our service, or we are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data

Law enforcement

Under certain circumstances, DTCF may be required to disclose your personal data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g. a court or a government agency).

Other legal requirements

DTCF may disclose your personal data in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to:

- Comply with a legal obligation
- Protect and defend the rights or property of DTCF
- Prevent or investigate possible wrongdoing in connection with the service
- Protect the personal safety of users of the service or the public
- Protect against legal liability

Security of Your Personal Data

The security of your personal data is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While DTCF strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Detailed Information on the Processing of Your Personal Data

The service providers we use may have access to your personal data. These third-party vendors collect, store, use, process and transfer information about your activity on our service in accordance with their Privacy Policies.

Analytics

DTCF may use third-party Service providers to monitor and analyze the use of our service.

Email Marketing

DTCF may use your personal data to contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information that may be of interest to you. You may opt-out of receiving any, or all, of these communications from us by following the unsubscribed link or instructions provided in any email we send or by contacting us.

Payments

DTCF may provide paid products and/or services within the service. In that case, we may use third-party services for payment processing (e.g. payment processors). We will not store or collect your payment card details. That information is provided directly to our third-party payment processors whose use of your personal information is governed by their Privacy Policy. These payment processors adhere to the standards set by PCI-DSS as managed by the PCI Security Standards Council, which is a joint effort of brands like Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover. PCI-DSS requirements help ensure the secure handling of payment information.

Sale of Personal Information of Minors Under 13 Years of Age

DTCF do not knowingly collect personal identifiable information from minors under the age of thirteen through our service. If you are under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use this website.

If you are a parent or guardian and you are aware that your child has provided DTCF with personal data, please contact us. If we become aware that we have collected personal data from anyone under the age of thirteen without verification of parental consent, we will take steps to remove that information from our server.

Changes to this Privacy Policy

DTCF may update our Privacy Policy from time to time. We will notify you of any changes by posting the new Privacy Policy on this page.

We will let you know about significant changes in the way we treat personal information by sending a notice to the primary email address specified in your account, by placing a prominent notice on our website, and/or by updating any privacy information.

You are advised to review this Privacy Policy periodically for any changes. Changes to this Privacy Policy are effective when they are posted on this page. Your continued use of the website after such modifications will constitute your acknowledgement of the modified Privacy Policy and agreement to abide and be bound by this policy.
